- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 12-47-21 and a new
- 2 subsection to section 12-47-36 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to wireless
- 3 electronic communications devices on or within premises under the control of the department of
- 4 corrections and rehabilitation and records of offenders; to amend and reenact subsection 7 of
- 5 section 12-47-21 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of contraband; to
- 6 repeal section 12-47-38 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to contracting with county
- 7 jails to house female prisoners; to provide a penalty; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 9 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 12-47-21 of the North Dakota Century Code 10 is created and enacted as follows:
 - a. It is unlawful for a penitentiary inmate to willfully manufacture, possess, or use a wireless electronic communications device on or within any premises under the control of the department of corrections and rehabilitation or any of its divisions.
 - b. It is unlawful for any person to willfully deliver, or possess with intent to deliver, a wireless electronic communications device to a penitentiary inmate or to any person for redelivery to a penitentiary inmate, or to allow a penitentiary inmate to possess or use a wireless electronic communications device, on or within any premises under the control of the department of corrections and rehabilitation or any of its divisions.
- 21 c. A violation of this subsection is a class C felony.
- 22 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 7 of section 12-47-21 of the North Dakota

I	7.	As used in this section, controlled substance is as defined in subsection 6 of
2		section 19-03.1-01 and includes counterfeit substances as defined in subsection 7
3		of section 19-03.1-01. As used in this section, "willfully" is as defined in section
4		12.1-02-02. As used in this section, "alcohol" and "alcoholic beverage" are as
5		defined in section 5-01-01. As used in this section, "tobacco" means any form of
6		tobacco, including cigarettes, cigars, snuff, or tobacco in any form in which it may
7		be used for smoking or chewing. As used in this section, a wireless electronic
8		communications device includes a cellular telephone, personal digital assistant,
9		pager, mobile broadband card, internet router, digital camera, two-way radio,
10		modem, or any other electronic device capable of wireless transmission, reception,
11		interception, or storage of oral communications, text, electronic mail, video or
12		photograph images, data signals, or radio communications, and also includes a
13		battery or component of a wireless electronic device, regardless whether the
14		component itself is able to transmit, store, or receive oral communications, text,
15		electronic mail, video or photograph images, data signals, or radio
16		communications.
17	SEC	CTION 3. A new subsection to section 12-47-36 of the North Dakota Century Code
18	is created a	and enacted as follows:
19		The medical, psychological, and treatment records of the department relating to
20		persons in the custody or under the supervision and management of the division of
21		adult services of the department of corrections and rehabilitation may be disclosed
22		for the purpose of conducting research and educational activities. A person
23		conducting research or educational activities may not redisclose identifying
24		information received under this subsection.
