- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of commerce to fund a
- 2 feasibility study for the construction of a marina and to the game and fish department to
- 3 construct a paved roadway and boat ramp.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the 6 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$300,000, or so much 7 of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the purpose of making a 8 grant to the New Town park board, to complete a feasibility study to construct a marina at 9 Arrowhead Point near New Town for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 10 2011. The study is to be completed in consultation with an advisory committee comprised of 11 representatives from the department of commerce, game and fish department, parks and 12 recreation department, state water commission, New Town park board, Three Affiliated Tribes, 13 and local stakeholder groups.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,700,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the game and fish department for the purpose of constructing a paved roadway and boat ramp near the marina at Arrowhead Point for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The game and fish department may not spend the general fund moneys until special funds, derived from federal funds or other private sources, are committed and secured for the construction of a marina near this location.
