1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 11-11-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the time and place of county commission meetings; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 11-11-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 11-11-05. Meetings of board - Time and place. The board of county commissioners 7 shall meet and hold sessions regular meetings for the transaction of business at the courthouse, or at the usual place of holding court, in the first week of January, April, July, and 8 9 October of each year, and may adjourn such meetings from time to time a time and place to be 10 designated by the commission on a date certain established by resolution or ordinance of the 11 commission. The county auditor shall have power to call special sessions meetings when the 12 interests of the county demand it. The chairman of the board, or a majority of the members 13 thereof, may call special sessions upon giving five days' notice of the time and object of the 14 meeting by publishing the notice in the official newspaper of the county, or by giving personal 15 notice, in writing, to all the members of the board meetings that must be noticed in accordance 16 with section 44-04-20.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
