1	A concurrent resolution urging the North Dakota Congressional Delegation and the Congress of
2	the United States to support worker freedom by opposing the federal Employee Free Choice
3	Act and any of the Act's related components.
4	WHEREAS, the right to a private secret ballot is fundamental to our representative
5	republic and should not be infringed upon; and
6	WHEREAS, state and federal law requires elections for public office or public votes on
7	initiatives and referenda be by private secret ballot; and
8	WHEREAS, passage of the federal Employee Free Choice Act could infringe upon the
9	rights of individuals to have a private ballot election; and
10	WHEREAS, the federal Employee Free Choice Act's mandatory binding arbitration
11	provisions would deny workers the right to participate in the collective bargaining process
12	between employees and the union; and
13	WHEREAS, any effort to eliminate private elections jeopardizes the free speech rights
14	of business and workers' individual rights; and
15	WHEREAS, North Dakota is a right-to-work state;
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA,
17	THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
18	That the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly urges the North Dakota Congressional
19	Delegation and the Congress of the United States to support worker freedom by opposing the
20	federal Employee Free Choice Act and any of the Act's related components; and
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly expresses
22	opposition to "card check" legislation such as the federal Employee Free Choice Act, finding
23	such legislation is detrimental to the rights of workers and is an offense against democratic
24	principles; and

- 1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
- 2 resolution to the Majority Leader of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States
- 3 House of Representatives, and to each member of the North Dakota Congressional Delegation.
