Engrossed SB 2032 extends the sunset on the sales and use tax exemption for wind-powered electrical generating facilities. It also includes plant expansions in the sales and use tax exemptions for power plants.

The extension of the sunset until 2015 could have a negative fiscal impact beginning with the final six months of the 2009-2011 biennium only, if any plants would be constructed during that timeframe. It is not known if the inclusion of power plant expansions in the existing sales tax exemption languate would have a negative fiscal impact in the 2009-2011 biennium as it would depend on any qualifying plant expansions that would occur.
