This bill increases the pre-need funeral set aside for Medicaid eligible clients from \$5,000 to \$6,000.

Section 1 of the bill increases the amount allowed to be set aside for pre-need funeral costs. It is estimated that 283 individuals per year will be impacted. Allowing the medicaid eligible client to set aside additional funds results in Medicaid paying a greater share of the medical costs. The Department estimates that only half of the \$1,000 increase will be spent on an individual's care. (283 x 2 years x \$1,000 x 1/2.)

The department will be able to access \$178,351 of federal Medicaid funding.
