

**SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 6001**

1 A resolution honoring Mr. Everett C. Albers for his unswerving devotion to bringing the  
2 humanities to the people of this state.

3 **WHEREAS**, since the inception of the North Dakota Humanities Council in 1973, the  
4 council has been an active participant in bringing the study of the humanities to the people of  
5 this state; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Albers, the longest serving executive director of a state humanities  
7 council in the United States, has served the people of this state through the North Dakota  
8 Humanities Council since the council's inception; and

9 **WHEREAS**, during his tenure, Mr. Albers has become nationally recognized for his  
10 untiring dedication to the study of the humanities and his boundless imagination in bringing  
11 programs of national scope as well as local importance to the people of this state; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Albers was instrumental in conceiving, constructing, and promoting the  
13 modern Great Plains Chautauqua, whose programs of modern scholars representing important  
14 historical figures has revived the 19th century tradition of summertime, outdoor education,  
15 discussion, and debate;

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

17 That the Senate honors Mr. Everett C. Albers for his unswerving devotion to bringing the  
18 humanities to the people of this state; and

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State present an enrolled copy of  
20 this resolution to Mr. Everett C. Albers.
