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## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

## SECTION 1. Mandatory alternative dispute resolution for professional malpractice cases. For purposes of this section, "professional malpractice claim" means a

- For purposes of this section, "professional malpractice claim" means a claim
  brought against a professional or other defendant joined in a claim alleging that an
  injury was suffered by the claimant as a result of professional misconduct.
- 2. Notwithstanding section 32-42-03, every professional malpractice claim filed with the district court, except for good cause as determined by the court.
  - a. Provide an equitable means for the payment of fees and expenses of the alternative dispute resolution processes; and
  - b. Provide that the damages awarded to a party as a result of the alternative dispute resolution process.
  - c. Provide that the damages awarded as a result.
- 16 <u>3.</u> The alternative dispute resolution methods provided for under the rules may
   17 include arbitration.
