- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a transportation voucher program; and to provide an
- 2 appropriation.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. Voucher program.** Within legislative appropriation, the department of
- 5 transportation may provide, contract with a third party, or provide grants to a third party to
- 6 administer a transportation voucher program. The program must provide assigned checks to
- 7 eligible participants for the payment of fees or reimbursement of mileage to transportation
- 8 providers. An assigned check may be used to defray the costs of a ride provided by a volunteer
- 9 driver or an existing transportation system. To be eligible, a participant must have a
- 10 <u>documented disability and an identifiable barrier to transportation.</u>
- 11 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 12 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$220,000, or so much
- of the sum as may be necessary, and from special funds the sum of \$780,000, or so much of
- 14 the sum as may be necessary, to the department of transportation for the purpose of creating
- and administering a transportation voucher system to increase ridership for individuals with
- disabilities for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
