A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 15-02-05, a new section to chapter 15-04, a new section to chapter 15-07, and a new subsection to section 20.1-03-39 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to duties of the commissioner of university and school lands, public access on original grant lands and nongrant lands, and regulation of guides; and to amend and reenact section 15-07-20 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to nongrant land leases.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 15-02-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows: 9 10 Identify by signage and publication all grant and nongrant lands that are open to 11 hunting. 12 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 15-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is 13 created and enacted as follows: 14 Lease of grant lands - Public access. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a 15 lessee of grant lands under this chapter may not post those lands to prohibit public access or 16 hunting on the lands. The board of university and school lands shall include a provision in each 17 lease executed after July 31, 2005, that the lessee may not post the leased land to prohibit 18 hunting during any open hunting season. 19 SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 15-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows: 20 21 Lease of nongrant lands - Public access. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 22 a lessee of nongrant lands under this chapter may not post those lands to prohibit public access 23 or hunting on the lands. The board of university and school lands shall include a provision in

each lease executed after July 31, 2005, that the lessee may not post the leased land to
 prohibit hunting during any open hunting season.

3 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 15-07-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is
4 amended and reenacted as follows:

5 **15-07-20.** Leasing of nongrant lands. The board of university and school lands may lease nongrant lands under reasonable rules as it may establish. The rules may provide for 6 7 leasing with or without advertisement or competitive bidding. Leases made under this section 8 must be for cash only, and the rental must be collected in advance except that the board may 9 collect a share of a conservation reserve program payment paid by the federal government. A 10 lease of nongrant lands may not extend for a period of more than five years, except any land 11 accepted into the conservation reserve program may have a lease term that coincides with the 12 term of the conservation reserve program contract if so provided in the lease. Leases may be 13 renewed at the discretion of the board. When nongrant lands are leased without advertisement 14 or competitive bidding, the board shall determine the rental by taking into consideration the 15 nature and adaptability of the lands and the improvements thereon. Leases made under this 16 section after July 31, 2005, must include a provision that the lessee may not post the land to 17 prohibit public access or hunting. 18 SECTION 5. A new subsection to section 20.1-03-39 of the North Dakota Century Code 19 is created and enacted as follows: 20 A guide or outfitter may not guide on any lands belonging to the state, including 21 grant lands, nongrant lands, and lands known as school lands and public institution

22 lands.
