| 4  | SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - STATE EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION                                      |
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| 5  | ADJUSTMENTS - GUIDELINES. It is the intent of the sixty-first legislative assembly that          |
| 6  | 2009-11 compensation adjustments for permanent state employees are to be based on                |
| 7  | documented performance and equity. General increases based on legislative appropriations         |
| 8  | are to be given beginning with the month of July 2009, to be paid in August 2009, and            |
| 9  | beginning with the month of July 2010, to be paid in August 2010. Each agency appropriation      |
| 10 | is increased by 5.0 percent for the first year of the 2009-11 biennium and 5.0 percent for the   |
| 11 | second year of the 2009-11 biennium.   |
| 12 | Increases for North Dakota university system employees are to average 5.0 percent fo             |
| 13 | the first year of the 2009-11 biennium and 5.0 percent for the second year of the 2009-11        |
| 14 | biennium.  |
| 15 | Employees whose documented performance levels do not meet standards are not                      |
| 16 | eligible for any salary increase.  |
| 17 | Probationary employees are not entitled to the general increases. However,                       |
| 18 | probationary employees may be given all or a portion of the increases effective in July, paid in |
| 19 | August, or upon completion of probation, at the discretion of the appointing authority.          |
| 20 | During the biennium, no salary increase other than a temporary increase may be given             |
| 21 | to an employee whose salary exceeds or would exceed the salary range maximum.                    |
