- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a dementia care services program; to provide for a report to the
- 3 legislative council; and to provide an appropriation.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:
- 7 **Dementia care services.** As used in this section, dementia means the condition of an
- 8 <u>individual involving loss of memory and other mental abilities severe enough to interfere with</u>
- 9 the individual's daily life. The department shall contract with a private provider for a dementia
- 10 <u>care services program in each area of the state served by a regional human service center.</u>
- 11 The dementia care services must include:
- 1. Identifying available services within the region;
- 2. Providing information to medical professionals, law enforcement, and the public
- regarding the symptoms of dementia, the benefits of early detection and treatment,
- and the services available to individuals with dementia and their caregivers;
- 16 3. Assessing the needs of individuals with dementia and their caregivers;
- 17 <u>4.</u> <u>Training care providers to manage and provide for the care of individuals with</u>
- 18 <u>dementia;</u>
- 19 <u>5. Providing consultation services to individuals with dementia and their caregivers;</u>
- 20 <u>and</u>
- 21 <u>6. Facilitating the referral of individuals with dementia and their caregivers to</u>
- 22 <u>appropriate care and support services.</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
- 24 **SERVICES.** During the 2009-10 interim, the department of human services shall report to the

- 1 legislative council after June 30, 2010, regarding the outcomes of the dementia care services
- 2 program, including the estimated long-term care service costs avoided as a result of the
- 3 program.
- 4 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 5 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,200,000, or so
- 6 much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of
- 7 providing the dementia care services program under section 1 of this Act for the biennium
- 8 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
