1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to payments for summer school courses and programs; and to amend  
3 and reenact section 15.1-27-19 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to payments for  
4 summer school courses and programs.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
7 created and enacted as follows:

8 **Summer school courses and programs - Eligibility for payment.** The summer  
9 school courses and programs for which a school district may receive payment, as provided in  
10 section 15.1-27-19, are:

- 11 1. a. Remedial mathematics provided to students enrolled in any grade from  
12 kindergarten through eight;
- 13 b. Remedial reading provided to students enrolled in any grade from  
14 kindergarten through eight;
- 15 c. Mathematics provided to students enrolled in any grade from five through  
16 nine;
- 17 d. Reading provided to students enrolled in any grade from five through nine;
- 18 e. Science provided to students enrolled in any grade from five through nine;  
19 and
- 20 f. Social studies provided to students enrolled in any grade from five through  
21 nine; and
- 22 2. Any other high school summer courses that satisfy requirements for graduation,  
23 comprise at least as many clock-hours as courses offered during the regular school  
24 term, and comply with rules adopted by the superintendent of public instruction.

1           **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-27-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
2 amended and reenacted as follows:

3           **15.1-27-19. Summer school courses and programs - Payments to school districts.**

- 4           1. Before a weight may be assigned under section 15.1-27-03.1 for a student enrolled  
5 in a high school summer course, the superintendent of public instruction shall verify  
6 that the course meets the criteria set forth in section 1 of this Act, satisfies  
7 requirements for graduation, comprises at least as many clock-hours as courses  
8 offered during the regular school term, and complies with rules adopted by the  
9 superintendent of public instruction.
- 10          2. Before a weight may be assigned under section 15.1-27-03.1 for a student enrolled  
11 in an elementary summer program, the superintendent of public instruction shall  
12 verify that the program meets the criteria set forth in section 1 of this Act and  
13 complies with rules adopted by the superintendent of public instruction.
