1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 12.1-17-09 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the killing or injury of a law enforcement support animal; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-17-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 12.1-17-09. Killing or injury of certified, law enforcement support dog - Definition
7 - Penalty.

8	<u>1.</u>	<u>a.</u>	<u>a.</u> A person is guilty of a class A <u>B</u> misdemeanor and is subject to a civil penalty	
9			of up	to ten thousand dollars if that person willfully:
10			<u>(1)</u>	Harasses, taunts, provokes, or torments a law enforcement support
11				animal;
12			<u>(2)</u>	Interferes with a law enforcement support animal while the animal is
13				working; or
14			<u>(3)</u>	Interferes with the individual handling the animal.
15		<u>b.</u>	<u>A pe</u>	son is guilty of a class B felony if that person willfully and unjustifiably
16			<u>harm</u>	s a law enforcement support animal.
17		<u>C.</u>	<u>A pe</u>	son is guilty of a class B felony if that person willfully and unjustifiably
18			kills,	shoots, tortures, torments, beats, kicks, strikes, mutilates, disables, or
19			other	wise injures a certified,:
20			<u>(1)</u>	Causes debilitating bodily injury to a law enforcement support dog
21				animal;
22			<u>(2)</u>	Causes the death of a law enforcement support animal.
23	<u>2.</u>	For purposes of this section, "certified, a law enforcement support dog animal"		
24		means any <u>a</u> dog <u>that is certified for use in, or a horse</u> used by a <u>in,</u> law

- enforcement officer in the performance of the officer's functions and duties,
 <u>corrections, arson investigation, or search and rescue,</u> regardless of whether the
 dog animal is on or off duty.
 <u>This section does not apply to a law enforcement officer or a veterinarian who</u>
 terminates the life of a certified, law enforcement support dog animal to relieve the
