- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15.1-20-01, 15.1-20-02, and 15.1-22-01, and
- 2 subsection 1 of section 57-15-14.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to compulsory
- 3 kindergarten attendance.

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## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-20-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

## 15.1-20-01. Compulsory attendance.

- a. Each child who resides in this state and who has reached the age of compulsory attendance, as set forth in this section, shall enroll in and attend for the duration of the program, a full-day or a half-day public school kindergarten program, approved by the superintendent of public instruction.
  - Nothing in this subsection prevents a younger child from enrolling in and attending a public school kindergarten program, approved by the superintendent of public instruction, provided the child meets the requirements of section 15.1-06-01.
  - <u>Upon successful completion of a full-day or a half-day public school</u>
    <u>kindergarten program, approved by the superintendent of public instruction,</u>
    <u>the child shall enroll in and attend the remainder of the public school grades,</u>
    beginning with grade one.
- 2. Any person having responsibility for a child between the ages of seven and sixteen years shall ensure that the child is in attendance at a public school for the duration of each school year.
