## "SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY SYSTEM CAPITAL

**PROJECTS.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the North Dakota university system for the capital projects listed below, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

**SECTION 9. CONTINGENT FUNDING - SWAIN HALL PROJECT.** Section 8 of this Act includes \$6,500,000 from the general fund for the Swain hall project at Minot state university which may be spent only to the extent that federal funds appropriated in section 10 of this Act are not available for this project.

SECTION 10. APPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FISCAL STIMULUS FUNDS - ADDITIONAL FUNDING APPROVAL. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated from federal funds made available to the state under the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, not otherwise appropriated, to the North Dakota university system, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

The North Dakota university system may seek emergency commission and budget section approval under chapter 54-16 for authority to spend any additional federal funds received under the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 in excess of the amounts appropriated under this section, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2011.

Any federal funds appropriated under this section are not a part of the agency's 2011-13 base budget. Any program expenditures made with these funds will not be replaced with state funds after the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funds are no longer available.

**SECTION 11. APPROPRIATION - VIRTUAL CENTER FOR CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION.** There is appropriated from special funds derived from federal funds or other income from gifts, grants, or donations, the sum of \$3,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to Williston state college for the purpose of constructing a virtual center for career and technical education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

**SECTION 12. EMERGENCY.** Section 10 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure."
