- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to establishing a hunting mentorship program; and to amend and
- 3 reenact section 20.1-03-01.3 and subsection 1 of section 20.1-03-11 of the North Dakota
- 4 Century Code, relating to hunter education and age requirements.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-03-01.3 of the North Dakota Century Code 7 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **20.1-03-01.3. Exemptions.** Sections 20.1-03-01.1 through 20.1-03-01.3 and 9 20.1-03-01.2 do not apply to:
 - Persons Individuals under twelve years of age who hunt only with their parent or legal guardian.
- Persons Individuals who hunt exclusively on land of which they are the record title
 owner or operator.
 - 3. Individuals hunting with a mentor as provided under section 3 of this Act.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 20.1-03-11 of the North Dakota

 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 1. No person shall An individual may not hunt, kill, take, or attempt to take any big game without having the appropriate big game hunting license and a locking seal bearing a number corresponding to the number of the big game hunting license or stamp. The locking seal shall must be issued as an integral part of the big game hunting license. No person Except as provided in section 3 of this Act, an individual may not apply for or be issued a big game hunting license if that person's fourteenth birthday does not occur on or before the opening date of the respective big game hunting season. This age limitation does not apply to

9		<u>a.</u>	At all times while hunting, the individual is within arm's reach of a mentor who	
10			meets the qualifications of subsection 2;	
11		<u>b.</u>	The individual holds all required licenses and stamps.	
12	<u>2.</u>	<u>An i</u>	ndividual may not serve as a mentor for a hunter unless:	
13		<u>a.</u>	The mentor is 18 years of age or older;	
14		<u>b.</u>	The mentor is the parent or guardian of the individual for whom the individual	
15			is serving as a mentor or is authorized by the parent or guardian to serve as a	
16			mentor. This requirement does not apply to an individual serving as a mentor	
17			for an individual who is 18 years of age or older;	
18		<u>C.</u>	At all times while serving as a mentor, the mentor is within arm's reach of the	
19			individual for whom the mentor is serving as a mentor;	
20		<u>d.</u>	The mentor possesses a hunter safety education course certificate of	
21			completion, unless that individual was born before January 1, 1961, and is not	
22			required to obtain a hunter safety education course certificate of completion;	
23			<u>and</u>	
24		<u>e.</u>	The mentor holds all required licenses and stamps.	
25	<u>3.</u>	<u>A m</u>	entor under this section may take only one individual, for whom the individual is	
26		serv	ving as a mentor, hunting at a time.	
27	<u>4.</u>	The director shall develop and issue a pamphlet containing hunter safety		
28		information to each individual hunting under this section who is not required to		
29		possess a hunter safety education course certificate of completion.
