- 1 A BILL for an Act to require the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability of
- 2 transferring the facilities and property of the State Hospital from the Department of Human
- 3 Services to the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY- TRANSFER OF FACILITIES AND
  - PROPERTY OF STATE HOSPITAL TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND
- 7 **REHABILITATION.** The Legislative Council shall study during the 2009-10 interim, the
- 8 feasibility and desirability of transferring the facilities and property of the State Hospital from the
- 9 Department of Human Services to the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation. The study
- 10 must include consideration of the voluntary transfer of employees of the Department of Human
- 11 Services to the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation who are responsible for the
- 12 treatment of mental health and addiction issues of inmates the feasibility of the Department of
- 13 Human Services entering contracts with community hospitals for the treatment of individuals
- 14 with mental illnesses. During the study, the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and
- 15 the Department of Human Services shall develop and propose plans to accomplish the transfer
- 16 and present the proposals to the Legislative Council. The Legislative Council shall report its
- 17 findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the
- 18 recommendations, to the 62nd Legislative Assembly.
