## HOUSE BILL NO.

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 48-09-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to the granting of concessions for a restaurant within the capital complex.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 48-09-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **48-09-01. Granting of concessions for cafes, restaurants, and confectioneries on**  
7 **public buildings and grounds.**

8 1. Any Except as provided in subsection 2, a state official, board, or commission, any  
9 county official, board, or commission, and any municipal officer, board, or  
10 commission, having the supervision, control, and management of any state,  
11 county, or municipal building and the adjacent grounds thereof, when it is deemed  
12 to be for the public benefit and good, may grant a concession therein or thereon for  
13 any cafe, restaurant, or confectionery, by renting, leasing, and licensing any such  
14 concession to the highest bidder or best bidder, or both, at a reasonable rental per  
15 month, for a period not exceeding eight years, and may reject any and all bids  
16 therefor. Provided, the board of directors of any North Dakota fair association or  
17 board of county park commissioners may grant a concession under this chapter  
18 without letting bids.

19 2. The office of management and budget shall provide for the operation of a  
20 restaurant within the capital building. The restaurant must be operated by the  
21 office of management and budget and all employees of the restaurant must be  
22 employees of the office of management and budget. The office of management  
23 and budget may not grant a concession for a restaurant within the capitol building.
