1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 48-09-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the granting of concessions for a restaurant within the state capitol; to provide an

3 effective date; and to declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 48-09-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 48-09-01. Granting of concessions for cafes, restaurants, and confectioneries on public buildings and grounds.

9	<u>1.</u>	Any Except as provided in subsection 2, a state official, board, or commission, any
10		county official, board, or commission, and any municipal officer, board, or
11		commission, having the supervision, control, and management of any state,
12		county, or municipal building and the adjacent grounds thereof, when it is deemed
13		to be for the public benefit and good, may grant a concession therein or thereon for
14		any cafe, restaurant, or confectionery, by renting, leasing, and licensing any such
15		the concession to the highest bidder or best bidder, or both, at a reasonable rental
16		per month, for a period not exceeding eight years, and may reject any and all bids
17		therefor. Provided, the board of directors of any North Dakota fair association or
18		board of county park commissioners may grant a concession under this chapter
19		without letting bids.
20	<u>2.</u>	The office of management and budget may not grant a concession for a restaurant
04		within the state conital, but shall provide for the establishment of a restaurant within

within the state capitol, but shall provide for the establishment of a restaurant within
 the state capitol which must be operated by the office of management and budget.
 All employees of the restaurant must be employees of the office of management
 and budget.

- 1 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
- 2 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
