A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 5-01-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
 relating to the manufacture of alcoholic beverage.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 5-01-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

6 5-01-04. Manufacture of alcoholic beverages prohibited - Exceptions. A person 7 may manufacture alcoholic beverages for personal or family use, and not for sale, without 8 securing a license if the amount manufactured is within quantities allowed by the bureau of 9 alcohol, tobacco, firearms and explosives of the United States treasury department. Any 10 person manufacturing alcoholic beverages within this state in quantities greater than those 11 permitted by the United States treasury department is guilty of a class A misdemeanor and 12 property used for same is subject to disposition by the court except any person may establish a 13 brewery for the manufacture of malt beverages, a winery, or a distillery or other plant for the 14 distilling, manufacturing, or processing of alcohol within this state if the person has secured a 15 license from the state tax commissioner. This license must be issued on a calendar-year basis 16 with a fee of five hundred dollars. A first-time license fee may be reduced twenty-five percent 17 for each full guarter of a year elapsed between the first day of the year for which the license is issued and the date on which the application for the license is filed with the state tax 18 19 commissioner. A license may not be issued for any period for a fee less than one-half of the 20 annual license fee. This license shall allow sale to only licensed wholesalers unless for the 21 manufacture of wine, then retail sales of manufactured wine may be made on premises.
