**ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2329**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide for an appropriation and transfer for creating geographic  
2 information system-based maps or overlays; and to provide an appropriation to the state  
3 historical society for the purpose of coordinating the mapping project.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - TRANSFER - GEOLOGIC DATA PRESERVATION**

6 **FUND.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not  
7 otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$290,000, which the office of management and budget shall  
8 transfer to the geologic data preservation fund for the industrial commission to use for  
9 identifying historical trails and creating geographic information system-based maps or overlays  
10 of these trails for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

11 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY.** There is  
12 appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise  
13 appropriated, the sum of \$290,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state  
14 historical society for the purpose of coordinating, by contracting for consulting services if  
15 necessary, the mapping project provided for in section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning  
16 July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

17 **SECTION 3. ADDITIONAL INCOME.** Any other funds received by the industrial  
18 commission from federal or other sources for the mapping project, in addition to the funds  
19 appropriated in section 1 of this Act, must be deposited in the geologic data preservation fund  
20 for defraying the costs of the project, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending  
21 June 30, 2011.

22 **SECTION 4. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION.** Any other funds received  
23 by the historical society from federal or other sources for the mapping project, in addition to the

- 1 funds appropriated in section 2 of this Act, are appropriated to the state historical society for the
- 2 project, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
