1 A BILL for an Act relating to the comprehensive statewide tobacco prevention and control plan;

- 2 and to create and enact a new section to chapter 6-09 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to qualified college savings plans for tobacco-free students.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 6-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 6 created and enacted as follows:

Qualified college savings plans - Tobacco-free students. The Bank of North Dakota
 shall provide a grant in the amount of one thousand dollars to any qualified college savings plan
 authorized by section 529 of the Internal Revenue Code provided:

- 10 <u>1.</u> The plan is opened by a resident of this state who is the parent of the beneficiary;
- 11 <u>2.</u> <u>The beneficiary is born after August 1, 2009;</u>
- 12 <u>3.</u> The parent of the beneficiary has contributed at least five hundred dollars to the
 plan;
- <u>4.</u> The parent of the beneficiary agrees in writing to do all things necessary and
 proper to ensure that the beneficiary does not illegally purchase, possess, smoke,
- 16 or use cigarettes, cigars, cigarette papers, snuff, or tobacco in any other form in
- 17 which it may be utilized for smoking or chewing while under the age of eighteen;
 18 and
- 19 <u>5.</u> The parent of the beneficiary agrees in writing that if the beneficiary is convicted of 20 violating any state law or local ordinance pertaining to the illegal purchase,
- 21 possession, or use of tobacco in any form while under the age of eighteen the
- 22 parent shall repay one thousand dollars to the Bank of North Dakota.
- 23 SECTION 2. <u>Tobacco prevention and control advisory committee Development</u>
- 24 of comprehensive plan. The tobacco prevention and control advisory committee shall

- 1 include, as part of the comprehensive statewide tobacco prevention and control plan, support
- 2 and funding for the provision of grants to qualified college savings plans on behalf of
- 3 <u>beneficiaries who remain tobacco-free as provided for in section 1 of this Act.</u>
