BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 created and enacted as follows:

Introduction of bills by executive and judicial branches - restrictions. Except as

- provided in this section, no bill may be introduced by an executive branch agency or the judicial
- 10 branch unless the bill is introduced by a member of the legislative assembly on behalf of the
- 11 agency or judicial branch. A director of the budget shall file with the legislative council bills
- 12 making appropriations to implement the executive budget no later than December 10 before the
- 13 ensuing regular session of the legislative assembly. The supreme court shall file with the
- 14 legislative council a bill to implement the budget request of the judicial branch no later than
- December 10 before the ensuing regular session. The bills submitted by the director of the 15
- 16 budget and the supreme court are deemed introduced by the appropriations committees of the
- 17 senate or the house of representatives.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 54-44.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is 18 19 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 20 54-44.1-07. Presentation of budget data - How presented to the legislative
- 21 assembly. The director of the budget or the director's designee shall present the budget data
- 22 information in section 54-44.1-06, except the drafts of acts required by subsection 7 of that
- 23 section, and make available sufficient copies thereof to the legislative assembly at the
- 24 organizational session. The drafts of acts required by subsection 7 of section 54-44.1-06 must

- 1 be submitted to the legislative council within seven days after the day of adjournment of the
- 2 organizational session by December 10 of that year. The budget data must be completed and
- 3 made available to the legislative assembly in such form as may be prescribed by the legislative
- 4 council. The legislative council shall set the time and place at which such budget data is to be
- 5 presented.
