BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 created and enacted as follows:

Introduction of bills by executive and judicial branches - Restrictions. Except as provided in this section, a bill may not be introduced by an executive branch agency or the judicial branch. The director of the budget shall file with the legislative council bills making

11 appropriations to implement the executive budget no later than December tenth before the

ensuing regular session of the legislative assembly. The supreme court shall file with the

legislative council a bill to implement the budget request of the judicial branch no later than

December tenth before the ensuing regular session. A bill submitted by the director of the

budget or the supreme court is deemed introduced by the appropriations committees of the

16 senate or the house of representatives.

> SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 54-44.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

54-44.1-07. Presentation of budget data - How presented to the legislative

20 assembly. The director of the budget or the director's designee shall present the budget data information in section 54-44.1-06, except the drafts of acts required by subsection 7 of that

22 section, and make available sufficient copies thereof of the budget data to the legislative

23 assembly at the organizational session. The drafts of acts required by subsection 7 of section

24 54-44.1-06 must be submitted to the legislative council within seven days after the day of Sixty-first Legislative Assembly

- 1 adjournment of the organizational session by December tenth of that year. The budget data
- 2 must be completed and made available to the legislative assembly in such form as may be
- 3 prescribed by the legislative council. The legislative council shall set the time and place at
- 4 which such budget data is to be presented.
