- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide legislative findings and authorize the governor to seize certain land
- 2 and transfer that land to the board of university and school lands.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND INTENT.** The legislative assembly finds 5 the following:
  - The economy and well-being of the residents of North Dakota is dependent upon agriculture.
  - The United States, through the army corps of engineers, has acquired certain lands around Lake Sakakawea and Lake Oahe.
    - The United States army corps corps of engineers has failed to control weeds and manage this land properly.
      - 4. This failure to control weeds on land managed by the United States army corps of engineers jeopardizes the public health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of this state.
    - That the state must exercise its police power for the protection of public health, safety, and general welfare of the state.

## 17 SECTION 2. SEIZURE OF LAND - TRANSFER TO BOARD OF UNIVERSITY AND

- 18 **SCHOOL LANDS.** On the effective date of this Act, the governor shall direct the state's
- 19 attorney of each county of this state in which lands adjacent to Lakes Sakakawea or Oahe is
- 20 located to seize that land and effect a transfer from the United States army corps of engineers
- 21 to the board of university and school lands. At the direction of the governor, the state's attorney
- 22 shall prepare any necessary documents and cause them to be recorded in the recorder's office
- 23 of the affected county.
