## HOUSE BILL NO. 1485

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-51.1-07.2 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to transfers to the permanent oil tax trust fund.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 57-51.1-07.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 57-51.1-07.2. (Contingent repeal See note) Permanent oil tax trust fund -
- 7 **Deposits Interest Adjustment of distribution formula.** All revenue deposited in the
- 8 general fund during a biennium derived from taxes imposed on oil and gas under chapters
- 9 57-51 and 57-51.1 which exceeds seventy-one one hundred ten million dollars must be
- 10 transferred by the state treasurer to a special fund in the state treasury known as the
- 11 permanent oil tax trust fund. The state treasurer shall transfer interest earnings of the
- 12 permanent oil tax trust fund to the general fund at the end of each fiscal year. The principal of
- 13 the permanent oil tax trust fund may not be expended except upon a two-thirds vote of the
- 14 members elected to each house of the legislative assembly.
- 15 If the distribution formulas under chapter 57-51 or 57-51.1 are amended effective after
- 16 June 30, <del>1997</del> 2009, the director of the budget shall adjust the seventy-one one hundred ten
- 17 million dollar amount in this section by the same percentage increase or decrease in the
- 18 amount of revenue allocable to the general fund after the change in the allocation formula, and
- 19 transfers to the permanent oil tax trust fund shall thereafter be made using that adjusted figure
- 20 so that the dollar amount of the transfers to the permanent oil tax trust fund is not increased or
- 21 decreased merely because of changes in the distribution formulas.
