## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. COMMISSIONER OF HIGHER EDUCATION - STUDY - INTERACTION 4 5 WITH AMERICAN INDIANS. The state commissioner of higher education shall study during 6 the 2009-10 interim, the interplay between the North Dakota university system and American 7 Indians. Specifically, the commissioner shall address ways in which the North Dakota 8 university system as a whole and the individual campuses can better interact with American 9 Indians through improved communication, collaboration, and relationship building activities. In 10 addition, the commissioner shall focus on ways in which American Indians can be encouraged 11 to pursue options in higher education, thereby bringing economic benefit to their families and 12 communities and ways in which the university system and the individual campuses can provide 13 tutoring, mentoring, and other types of assistance necessary to ensure that the retention rates 14 and graduation rates of American Indian students are increased. The commissioner shall 15 report any findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement 16 the recommendations, to the sixty-second legislative assembly.
