4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision d of subsection 2 of section 44-08-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - d. Fourth quarter is from twelve midnight to six a.m. and the sum must be the actual lodging expenses not to exceed fifty five sixty dollars plus any additional applicable state or local taxes. A political subdivision may reimburse an elective or appointive officer, employee, representative, or agent for actual lodging expenses.
- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision d of subsection 2 of section 44-08-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - d. Fourth quarter is from twelve midnight to six a.m. and the sum must be the actual lodging expenses not to exceed sixty sixty-five dollars plus any additional applicable state or local taxes. A political subdivision may reimburse an elective or appointive officer, employee, representative, or agent for actual lodging expenses.
- **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision d of subsection 2 of section 44-08-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - d. Fourth quarter is from twelve midnight to six a.m. and the sum must be the actual lodging expenses not to exceed sixty-five dollars plus any additional applicable state or local taxes an amount determined by rule by the director of the office of management and budget. Beginning August 1, 2011, the director

1	shall adopt rules to establish the lodging reimbursement by increasing the
2	amount by five dollars per year until the amount is equal to the rate as
3	established by the United State general services administration. The director
4	shall amend the rules when necessary to set the reimbursement at the same
5	rate and established by the United States general services administration for
6	federal lodging per diem. A political subdivision may reimburse an elective or
7	appointive officer, employee, representative, or agent for actual lodging
8	expenses.
9	SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 2 of this Act becomes effective on August 1,
10	, and section 3 of this Act becomes effective on August 1, 2011.
