## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. STUDY OF LINKING AND IMPROVING PUBLIC SITES ALONG THE
- 5 SIBLEY AND SULLY HISTORICAL TRAILS. The Parks and Recreation Department, State
- 6 Historical Society of North Dakota, Game and Fish Department, and the Tourism Division of the
- 7 Department of Commerce shall conduct a study of the feasibility and desirability of linking and
- 8 improving a series of public sites along the Sibley and Sully historic trails for purposes of
- 9 historical education, heritage tourism, and public hunting access. The Parks and Recreation
- 10 Department shall serve as the lead agency for the study and report the findings and
- 11 recommendations of the study to the Legislative Council by September 1, 2010.
