- 1 A BILL to provide for grants to the owners of fuel dispensing units that were required to be
- 2 retrofitted to accommodate sales of higher-priced fuels; and to provide an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the 5 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much 6 of the sum as may be necessary, to the public service commission for the purpose of providing 7 grants to owners of fuel dispensing units that were required during the period from April 1, 8 2008, through April 1, 2009, to be retrofitted to accommodate sales of higher-priced fuels, for 9 the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. To receive a grant from the 10 appropriation provided in this section, the owner of a fuel dispensing unit must file an 11 application with the public service commission, on a form provided by the public service 12 commission, providing the information necessary to verify the expense incurred and the 13 necessity of retrofitting a fuel dispensing unit to dispense fuels at a higher cost than the 14 maximum cost for which the unit was originally designed and manufactured. The grants 15 provided by this section are to offset costs for expenditures to retrofit fuel dispensing units from
