## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 7 of section 19-03.1-23 of the North Dakota
Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 7. Except as provided by section 19-03.1-45, a court may order a person who violates 7 this chapter or chapter 19-03.4 to undergo a drug addiction evaluation by a 8 licensed addiction counselor. The court shall order a person who violates this chapter or chapter 19-03.4 to undergo a drug addiction evaluation by a licensed 9 addiction counselor if the offense occurred while the person was operating a motor 10 11 vehicle or in actual physical control of a motor vehicle and suspend the license of 12 the person for thirty days. The evaluation must indicate the prospects for 13 rehabilitation and whether addiction treatment is required. If ordered, the 14 evaluation must be submitted to the court before imposing punishment for a felony 15 violation or a misdemeanor violation. If the person is found to be in need of alcohol 16 and substance abuse treatment and rehabilitation and has that person's license suspended under this subsection, the court shall require the defendant to complete 17 18 alcohol and substance abuse treatment and rehabilitation as a condition of the 19 return of driving privileges.
