1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-22-17 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating rental plates.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-22-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

39-22-17. Additional dealer plates - In-transit plates - Demonstration Rental plates

- 7 Fees Use of dealer plates Penalty.
- Additional dealer number plates must be issued to the dealer upon payment of a
 fee of twenty dollars each. A dealer number plate may be used on any vehicle
 owned by the dealership and used in the direct functions of demonstrating, buying,
 or selling vehicles. Dealer plates may not be used on a service vehicle or a vehicle
 used in other functions of the business, sold units in the possession of the
 purchaser, by family members not residing at the dealer's residence, or by a
 person not directly involved in the operation of the dealership.
- The department shall issue a dealer number plate to be used on a rental vehicle of
 a dealer for twenty dollars. A rental vehicle is a vehicle rented by a dealer acting as
 an automobile rental company to the public for a period of ninety days or less.
- A dealer plate displayed on a vehicle must be visibly displayed on the rear of the
 vehicle.
- 203. 4.The department may assess a person violating this section a one hundred dollar21fee for a first violation, a two hundred dollar fee for a second violation within two22years of the first violation, or a fee of at least five hundred dollars but not more than23two thousand dollars for a third or subsequent violation within five years of the first24violation.
