## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the creation of local passenger

- 2 rail transportation within this state.
- 3 **WHEREAS**, the cost of transportation by automobile has greatly increased due to the
- 4 increase in the price of petroleum products; and
- 5 WHEREAS, passenger rail provides a fuel-efficient transportation system, helping to
- 6 reduce America's dependence on foreign oil; and
- 7 WHEREAS, shifting transportation to rail service will lessen the burden of transportation
- 8 on the overstressed highway system infrastructure in this state; and
- 9 WHEREAS, railroad tracks unite many of the small towns in this state with cities that
- 10 contain shopping and medical facilities; and
- 11 WHEREAS, some of these cities connect to the Empire Builder Amtrak service
- 12 providing access to major cities in the United States; and
- 13 WHEREAS, this state is a member of the Midwest Interstate Passenger Rail Compact,
- 14 the purpose of which is to promote passenger rail service in the Midwest, and an effort to
- 15 combine a seamless local rail transit system with a regional system would provide an
- 16 energy-efficient and cost-effective means of travel throughout the region and, combined with
- 17 the Amtrak system, throughout the nation;

## 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

## 19 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 20 That the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly directs the Legislative Council to study the
- 21 creation of local passenger rail transportation within this state; and
- 22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
- 23 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 24 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
