1 A concurrent resolution authorizing the Budget Section of the Legislative Council to hold the 2 required legislative hearings on state plans for the receipt and expenditure of new or revised 3 block grants passed by Congress. 4 WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States enacted the Omnibus Budget 5 Reconciliation Act of 1981 creating the community services block grant program; and 6 WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly is required to conduct public hearings; and 7 WHEREAS, the Appropriations Committees have met the public hearing requirement for 8 community services block grant moneys expected for the next biennium by the Department of 9 Commerce; and 10 WHEREAS, the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly cannot hold public hearings on 11 revisions to current block grants or additional block grants that may be approved by Congress 12 after the recess or adjournment of the Legislative Assembly; and 13 WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly will not meet in regular session during 2010 and 14 thus its public hearing responsibility for grants not approved by the Sixty-first Legislative 15 Assembly must be delegated to a legislative entity; 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE _____ CONCURRING THEREIN: 17 18 That the Department of Commerce appropriation bill enacted by the Legislative 19 Assembly is the Legislative Assembly's approval of and contains directions regarding the use of 20 community services block grant moneys for the period ending September 30, 2011; and 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Budget Section of the Legislative Council may 22 hold the public legislative hearings required for the receipt of additional block grants or other 23 federal moneys under the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981 or other relevant federal
