SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

(Workers' Compensation Review Committee)

- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the state's workers' 2 compensation system and whether it is feasible and desirable in making a workers' 3 compensation eligibility determination to consider whether that injured worker qualified for 4 federal Social Security disability insurance or supplemental security income. 5 WHEREAS, during the 2005-06 and 2007-08 interims the Workers' Compensation 6 Review Committee reviewed workers' compensation claims that were brought to the committee 7 by injured workers for the purpose of determining whether changes should be made to the laws 8 relating to workers' compensation; and
 - **WHEREAS**, many of the injured workers who have had their workers' compensation claims reviewed by the Workers' Compensation Review Committee have been qualified to receive federal Social Security disability insurance or supplemental security income; and
 - **WHEREAS**, one of the reoccurring issues injured workers have brought to the attention of the Workers' Compensation Review Committee during the past two interims is the frustration of being found disabled under the federal program but being found employable under the state's workers' compensation system; and
 - **WHEREAS**, the Workers' Compensation Review Committee recognizes that although the federal disability programs and the state workers' compensation program are different programs with different parties, there are broad similarities between the programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Legislative Council study the state's workers' compensation system and whether it is feasible and desirable in making a workers' compensation eligibility determination to consider whether that injured worker qualified for federal Social Security disability insurance or supplemental security income; and

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- 1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
- 2 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 3 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
