## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

1	A concurrent resolution to create and enact a new section to article X of the Constitution of
2	North Dakota, relating to establishment and use of an oil tax trust fund; and to provide an
3	effective date.
4	STATEMENT OF INTENT
5	This measure establishes an oil tax trust fund an imposes limitations on use of moneys in the
6	fund.
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
8	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
9	That the following proposed new section to article X of the Constitution of North Dakota
10	is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the general
11	election to be held in 2010, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of
12	North Dakota.
13	SECTION 1. A new section to article X of the Constitution of North Dakota is created
14	and enacted as follows:
15	Fifteen percent of the state's share of all revenue during a biennium derived from taxes
16	imposed on oil and gas at the time of production or extraction which exceeds one hundred
17	million dollars must be transferred by the state treasurer to a special fund in the state treasury
18	known as the oil tax trust fund. The state treasurer shall transfer interest earnings of the oil tax
19	trust fund to the general fund at the end of each fiscal year. The principal of the oil tax trust
20	fund may not be expended except upon a vote of two-thirds of the members elected to each
21	house of the legislative assembly.
22	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. If approved by the voters, this measure becomes
23	effective on July 1, 2011.
