## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

1	A concurrent resolution urging Congress and the president to release information on and
2	address the public health issues of mercury in dental amalgams.
3	WHEREAS, a dental amalgam is the silver colored material used to fill teeth that have
4	cavities and is made out of nearly equal parts of liquid mercury and a powder containing silver,
5	tin, copper, zinc, and other metals; and
6	WHEREAS, the evaluation of dental amalgams by the United States Food and Drug
7	Administration has been surrounded in controversy, including a review by the United States
8	Department of Health and Human Services National Institutes of Health which has not been
9	released to the public; and
10	WHEREAS, some other countries, including Canada, France, and Sweden, follow a
11	precautionary principle and avoid the use of dental amalgams in pregnant women; and
12	WHEREAS, the Food and Drug Administration is funded in significant portion in user
13	fees which brings into question any study done by the Food and Drug Administration;
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
15	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
16	That the 61st Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States and the
17	president of the United States to release information on and address the public health issues of
18	mercury in dental amalgams; and
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
20	resolution to the chairman of the National Institutes of Health, the commissioner of the United
21	State Food and Drug Administration, to each member of the North Dakota congressional
22	delegation, and to the president of the United States.
