ı	A concurrent resolution urging Congress and the President to release information on and
2	address the public health issues of mercury in dental amalgams.
3	WHEREAS, a dental amalgam is the silver-colored material used to fill teeth that have
4	cavities and is made out of nearly equal parts of liquid mercury and a powder containing silver,
5	tin, copper, zinc, and other metals; and
6	WHEREAS, an evaluation of the safety of dental amalgams by the United States Food
7	and Drug Administration has been surrounded in controversy and has been reviewed by the
8	United States Department of Health and Human Services' National Institutes of Health in a
9	report that has not been released to the public; and
10	WHEREAS, Canada, France, and Sweden follow a precautionary principle and avoid
11	the use of dental amalgams in pregnant women; and
12	WHEREAS, the United States Food and Drug Administration is funded in significant
13	portion by user fees which brings into question the evaluation done by the United States Food
14	and Drug Administration;
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
16	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
17	That the sixty-first Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States and
18	the President of the United States to release information on and address the public health
19	issues of mercury in dental amalgams; and
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
21	resolution to the President of the United States, the chairman of the National Institutes of
22	Health, the commissioner of the United States Food and Drug Administration, and to each
23	member of the North Dakota Congressional Delegation.
