SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
2 of consolidation of state government business and reporting forms.

3 **WHEREAS**, business owners are required to complete and file numerous forms and
4 registrations with a number of state agencies before commencing business and after the
5 business is operational; and

6 **WHEREAS**, much of the information required on the forms is duplicative and could be
7 consolidated into one form; and

8 **WHEREAS**, by requiring business owners to complete numerous forms and deal with
9 several state agencies, and unnecessary burden is placed upon businesses;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
11 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

12 That the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability of consolidation of
13 state government business and reporting forms.

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
16 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
