1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
2	of consolidation of state government business and reporting forms.
3	WHEREAS, business owners are required to complete and file numerous forms and
4	registrations with a number of state agencies before commencing business and after the
5	business is operational; and
6	WHEREAS, much of the information required on the forms is duplicative and could be
7	consolidated into one form; and
8	WHEREAS, by requiring business owners to complete numerous forms and deal with
9	several state agencies, and unnecessary burden is placed upon businesses;
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
11	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
12	That the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability of consolidation of
13	state government business and reporting forms.
14	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
15	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
16	the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
