1 A concurrent resolution recognizing the importance of participation in Census 2010 and  
2 encouraging state agencies, political subdivisions, tribal governments, and all public officials to  
3 partner with the United States Census Bureau in achieving an accurate and complete count in  
4 Census 2010.

5 **WHEREAS**, because the Census is the basis for allocation of federal funds relating to  
6 social services and community development block grants and is the basis for redistricting of the  
7 Legislative Assembly, an accurate and complete count is vital to the entire state; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the results of the Census are used by federal, state, tribal, and local  
9 governments for planning purposes, business and economic development purposes, and  
10 funding decisions; and

11 **WHEREAS**, an accurate and complete count in Census 2010 will assist public officials  
12 and business leaders in making decisions related to business development and infrastructure  
13 needs; and

14 **WHEREAS**, census questionnaires take only a few minutes to complete and any  
15 identifying information provided through the questionnaire is held confidential for 72 years; and

16 **WHEREAS**, to achieve a full and complete count that includes segments of the  
17 population that have been traditionally undercounted, a partnership among the Census Bureau  
18 and the state, political subdivisions, tribal governments, and all public officials is vital in  
19 providing current and accurate information to the Census Bureau with respect to address lists,  
20 jurisdictional boundaries, and other geographical features;

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**  
22 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

23 That the Legislative Assembly recognizes the importance of participation in Census  
24 2010 and encourages state agencies, political subdivisions, tribal governments, and all public
