SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study space and facility needs of
state agencies to determine if efficiencies can be realized by constructing additional
state-owned facilities.
WHEREAS, the state of North Dakota maintains a State Capitol and Capitol complex
master plan; and
WHEREAS, the state of North Dakota leases office space in Bismarck for several of its
agencies and institutions; and
WHEREAS, the state should periodically evaluate office space needs and the cost of
leasing office space; and
WHEREAS, cost-savings may be realized by constructing additional facilities rather
than leasing space from private entities;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
That the Legislative Council study the Capitol complex master plan and state agency
office space needs to determine if any efficiencies can be realized by constructing additional
facilities to house state agencies; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
