HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study severed and abandoned
2	mineral rights.
3	WHEREAS, a quarter section of land may have hundreds of individuals with severed
4	mineral rights in relation to that quarter;
5	WHEREAS, the surface owner may or may not own any or all of the severed mineral
6	rights but is burdened entirely with the develop of those rights; and
7	WHEREAS, it is unknown who owns severed mineral rights, whether they be
8	governmental entities, residents, or nonresidents who may or may not actively manage the
9	mineral interests; and
10	WHEREAS, there are procedures for the termination of mineral interests in North
11	Dakota Century Code chapter 38-18.1 that should be reviewed to determine if the statutory
12	provisions are meeting the needs of the people of this state and if issues and abuses have
13	arisen due to the increased oil and gas activity in this state;
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
15	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
16	That the Legislative Council study the severed and abandoned mineral rights; and
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
18	recommendations together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
19	the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
