HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

1	A concurrent resolution affirming North Dakota's sovereignty under the Tenth Amendment to
2	the Constitution of the United States and to demand the federal government halt its practice of
3	assuming powers and of imposing mandates on the state's for purposes not innumerated in the
4	Constitution of the United States.
5	WHEREAS, the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States reads as
6	follows: "The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it
7	to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people"; and
8	WHEREAS, the Tenth Amendment defines the total scope of federal power as being
9	that specifically granted by the Constitution of the United States no more; and
10	WHEREAS, the scope of power defined by the Tenth Amendment means that the
11	federal government was created by the states specifically to be an agent of the states; and
12	WHEREAS, in 2009, the states are demonstrably treated as agents of the federal
13	government; and
14	WHEREAS, many powers assumed by the federal government and federal mandates
15	are directly in violation of the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States; and
16	WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court has ruled in New York v. United States,
17	112 S. Ct.2408 (1992), that Congress may not simply commandeers the legislative and
18	regulatory processes of the states; and
19	WHEREAS, a number of proposals from previous administrations and some now
20	pending from the present administration and from Congress may further violate the Constitution
21	of the United States;
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
23	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
24	That the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly affirms this state's sovereignty under the Tenth
25	Amendment to the Constitution of the United States over all powers not otherwise enumerated

- 1 and granted to the federal government by the Constitution of the United States and demands
- 2 the federal government to halt its practice of assuming powers and of imposing mandates upon
- 3 the states for purposes not innumerated by the Constitution of the United States; and
- 4 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
- 5 resolution to the President of the United States, the President of the United States Senate, the
- 6 Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, and to each member of the
- 7 North Dakota Congressional Delegation, and to the legislative bodies of each state.
