SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4036

- 1 A concurrent resolution urging the United States Department of Agriculture to implement
- 2 livestock indemnity program regulations that account for the fair market value of newborn
- 3 calves and their cost of production.
- 4 **WHEREAS**, the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 included a Supplemental
- 5 Agriculture Disaster Assistance Program; and
- 6 **WHEREAS**, the provisions governing indemnity for livestock deaths in excess of normal
- 7 mortality because of adverse weather are based on seventy-five percent of a fair market value,
- 8 as determined by the United States Secretary of Agriculture; and
- 9 **WHEREAS**, severely cold temperatures, excessive snowfall, and flood conditions have
- 10 marked the early months of 2009 and resulted in innumerable livestock losses and abnormally
- 11 high newborn livestock losses; and
- WHEREAS, indemnity provisions that base losses on the market value of a newborn
- 13 calf fail to account for the cost of production of that calf and the impact that such a loss has on
- 14 the ranchers of this state, their families, and their communities;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
- 16 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 17 That the Sixty-first Legislative Assembly urges the United States Department of
- 18 Agriculture to develop and implement, as quickly as possible, regulations governing its livestock
- 19 indemnity program and ensure that the program's indemnification calculations take into account
- 20 the fair market value of each newborn calf and its cost of production; and
- 21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
- 22 resolution to the United States Secretary of Agriculture and to each member of the North
- 23 Dakota Congressional Delegation.
