4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 57-20-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 57-20-03. Form of tax list. The tax list must be made out to correspond with the 8 assessment books as respects with respect to ownership and description of property, with 9 columns for the valuation and for the various items of tax included in the total amount of all 10 taxes set down opposite such description of property. The amounts of special taxes must be 11 entered in appropriate columns, but the general taxes may be shown by entering the rate of 12 each tax at the head of the proper column without extending the same, in which case a 13 schedule of the rates of such taxes must be made on the first page of each tax list. The tax lists 14 also must show, in a separate column, the years for which a tax lien has been foreclosed upon 15 any piece or parcel has been sold for taxes, if the same has not been redeemed or deeded for 16 such taxes.
