- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 57-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to valuation of property eligible for the federal low income housing tax
- 3 credit program; and to provide an effective date.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 57-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:
- 7 Valuation of low income housing tax credit properties. In assessing property that is
- 8 eligible for the low income housing tax credit under section 42 of the Internal Revenue Code [26]
- 9 U.S.A. 42], the assessor shall consider the productive and earning capacity of the property from
- 10 the actual rents received by the property owner, including the extent to which the use of the
- 11 property for low income housing reduces the market value of the property. For the purposes of
- 12 determining the true and full value of the property under this section, any low income housing
- 13 tax credits earned by the property owner must be considered income from the property. The
- 14 property owner shall, upon request, provide income information to the assessor. If the use of
- 15 the property no longer complies with the requirements of section 42 of the Internal Revenue
- 16 Code [26 U.S.C. 42], or if the property owner fails to provide the information requested by the
- 17 assessor, the assessor may use the best information available to determine the value of the
- 18 property and may apply generally accepted valuation methods used for valuation and
- 19 assessment of rental property.
- 20 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** The Act is effective tax years beginning after
- 21 December 31, 2008.
