1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the attorney general;

2 and to amend and reenact section 54-12-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the

3 salary of the attorney general.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 6 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 8 other income, to the attorney general for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the attorney 9 general, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

9	SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME - GAMING AND EXCISE TAX ALLOCATION					
10	FUND - LOCAL GAMING ENFORCEMENT GRANTS. The grants line item in section 1 of this					
11	Act includes \$617,000 for local gaming enforcement grants.					
12	SECTION 4. FIRE AND TORNADO FUND - FEES. The attorney general shall charge					
13	and collect fees for services provided by the state fire marshal program to entities covered by					
14	the fire and tornado fund under chapter 26.1-22. Fees under this section may be collected in					
15	amounts of up to a total of \$310,000 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending					
16	June 30, 2009. All fees collected under this section must be deposited in the attorney general's					
17	operating fund.					
18	SECTION 5. PETROLEUM RELEASE COMPENSATION FUND - FEES. The attorney					
19	general shall charge and collect fees for services provided by the state fire marshal program to					
20	entities covered by the petroleum release compensation fund under chapter 23-37. Fees under					
21	this section may be collected in amounts of up to a total of \$35,000 for the biennium beginning					
22	July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009. All fees collected under this section must be					
23	deposited in the attorney general's operating fund.					
24	SECTION 6. ADDITIONAL FEDERAL FUNDS - EMERGENCY COMMISSION					
25	APPROVAL - LIMIT ON GENER	AL FUND EXPENDIT	URES. If the attorne	y general receives		
26	federal funding in excess of federal funding amounts appropriated for the 2009-11 biennium,					
27	the attorney general may spend the additional federal funds, subject to emergency commission					
28	approval, but may not spend funding appropriated from the general fund or the					
29	multijurisdictional task force grant fund for similar purposes for the biennium beginning July 1,					
30	2009, and ending June 30, 2011.					

SECTION 7. AMENDMENT. Section 54-12-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 54-12-11. Salary of attorney general. The annual salary of the attorney general is
  eighty-three <u>ninety-one</u> thousand <u>nine seven</u> hundred <u>ninety-one</u> <u>nineteen</u> dollars through
  June 30, 2008, and <u>eighty seven</u> <u>ninety-six</u> thousand three hundred <u>fifty-one four</u> dollars
- 6 thereafter.
