1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the labor
2 commissioner; and to provide legislative intent.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
7 other income, to the labor commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that
8 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:
